Ernest Frank Braun was born December 24, 1920 in Terre Haute, Indiana to Arthur Anton Braun (father) and Velma Genice Hoffer Braun (mother). The family moved to Mount Joy, PA where he lived with his brother — Larry Allen Braun and sister — Mary Lucille Braun. Later, his family moved to Lancaster PA where his father worked for the Bauchman Chocolate Factory. At an early age he enjoyed participating in 4 different sports in school. Following high school he joined the Army and was stationed at the Middletown Air Depot (a suburb of Harrisburg, PA). When Pearl Harbor was attacked (December 7, 1941) he transferred to Hawaii to help rebuild damaged airplanes. He later joined the Air Force! After his assignment in Hawaii he subsequently transferred to Orlando, FL where - in 1946 - he met and married the former Anita Bernadette Calami. In 1951 their first child (Linda) was born followed by Karen (1954) and Ernest, Jr (1956)! Following military service Ernie worked for the Hamilton Watch Company in Lancaster, PA and later moved his family to Warner Robins, GA in 1966 where he worked (Civil Service) retiring in 1982. Ernie and Anita shared 54 wonderful years together until her death in 2000.



A new chapter unfolded in Ernie's life when - in 2003 - he married the former Sue Gilbert Sevin! It's true that behind every great man there's a great woman and Sue is no exception! They enjoy the Warner Robins Senior's Club, the Centerville Senior's Club, AARP Chapter 1952, their church (Trinity United Methodist) where Ernie has been a member since 1967, their neighborhood and volunteer with all these groups! Ernie continued playing softball and bowling in the church leagues until his "early 80s!"


