

Stimulus Payment Tool: This tool is for people who normally don't have to file a tax return, but need to do so this year to get a Stimulus Payment. This tool asks you a few questions and then fills in the 1040A tax form for you, using information you provide. Just print it out, sign it, mail it in, and get your stimulus payment check. It's quick and easy to do! Once you print the 1040A tax form or exit the tool, your personal data is automatically deleted. The Stimulus Payment Tool is an extension of the service AARP Tax-Aide volunteers currently provide to taxpayers across the country, and was developed in cooperation with BenefitsCheckUp, a service of the National Council on Aging. Unfortunately for the attorney - almost two weeks after his wallet was stolen - all the damage had been done. However, since doing the actions above there were no reported additional damages. Thanks to Sue Braun for providing the above information.

1. DO NOT sign the back of your credit cards. Instead, put "PHOTO ID REQUIRED."
2. When writing checks to pay on credit card accounts DO NOT put the complete account number on the "For" line. Instead just put the last four (4) numbers. The credit card company knows the rest of the number and anyone who might be handling your check as it passes through all the check processing channels won't have access to it.
3. Put your phone number on your check instead of your home phone number. If you have a P.O. Box use it instead of your home address. If you do not have a P.O. Box use your work address. NEVER HAVE YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER PRINTED ON YOUR CHECKS!
4. Place the contents of your wallet on a photocopy machine. Do both sides of each license, credit card, etc. If your wallet is stolen you'll know it's contents, account numbers and other information to call/cancel. Keep the photocopies in a safe place. Also carry a photocopy of your passport... especially when traveling abroad.
5. The attorney had first hand experience when his wallet was stolen. Within a week, the thief(s) purchased several expensive items, applied (and got approved) for a credit card with a high credit line, received a PIN from the DMV to change his driving information online. Because of that incident he provided the following ADDITIONAL tips:
6. In addition to cancelling credit cards the key s having the toll-free numbers and your card numbers hand so you'll know whom to call. Keep that information where you can find it! Immediately call the following: Equifax: 800/525-6286, Experian: 888/397-3742, Trans Union: 800/680-7289 and Social Security Administration (Fraud Line): 800/269-0271 to place a FRAUD ALERT on your name. The FRAUD ALERT means any company that checks your credit knows your information was stolen and they have to contact you by phone to authorize new credit.
