

The researchers say that for the first time, they were able to measure how the qualityadjusted life expectancy (QALE) of all Americans had changed over time. "QALE tells us more than how long a person can expect to live. It tells us what the relative guality of those added years are in terms of physical, emotional and mental well-being," says Dr. Allison Rosen, associate professor of Quantitive Health Sciences at UMMS. In detail, the study authors say that in terms of life-expectancy, a person who is 25-years-old today can

in 1987, while a 65-year-old can expect to live 1.7 years longer. ggd 😳

Remembering Shirley Temple Black Shirley Temple Black was a dimpled, precocious and determined little girl in the 1930s who sang and tap-danced her way to a height of Hollywood stardom and worldwide fame that no other child has reached. From 1935 to **1939** she was the most popular movie star in America, with Clark Gable a distant second. After winning an honorary Academy Award at the age of 6 and earning \$3 million before puberty, Shirley Temple grew up to be a level-headed adult. In **1972**, Black was diagnosed with breast cancer and underwent a mastectomy. She publicly discussed her surgery to educate women about the disease and is widely credited with helping to make it acceptable to talk about breast cancer.

No Shirley Temple movie was complete without a song — most famously "On the Good Ship Lollipop" and "Animal Crackers in My Soup" — and a tap dance. with partners including George Murphy, Jack Haley and Buddy Ebsen. But her most successful partnership was with the legendary African-American entertainer Bill (Bojangles) Robinson. She may have been the first white actress allowed to hold hands affectionately with a black man on screen, and her staircase dance with Mr. Robinson in "The Little Colonel," the first of four movies they made together, retains its magic almost 80 years later.



As Ambassador Shirley Temple Black, she was soft-spoken and earnest in postings in Czechoslovakia and Ghana, out to disprove concerns that her previous career made her a diplomatic lightweight. The Screen Actors Guild gave her its 2005 Life Achievement Award, and in her acceptance speech posted on the group's website, she said: "I have one piece of advice for those of you who want to receive the Lifetime Achievement Award: start early!"

Black is survived by her children, Susan, Charlie Jr., and Lori, her granddaughter Teresa and her great-granddaughters Lily and Emma.
