A few days later he received a letter from his son. "Dear Papa, Don't dig up that garden. That's where the bodies are buried. Love, Vinnie"










Highlights From August's Meeting: Our speaker was Jeremy Wixon (Education Program Manager/Go Fish Education Center). According to Wixson and also stated at the center's website "Georgia boasts over 4,000 miles of trout streams, 12,000 miles of warmwater streams and more than one-half million acres of impoundments. More than 1.1 million anglers of all ages fish in Georgia. These anglers spend about \$1 billion annually on fishing, having a total annual impact of over \$2 billion to the state's economy. Developed as part of the Go Fish Georgia Initiative, this center is core to promoting and increasing participation of fishing in Georgia. Additionally, The Go Fish Georgia Initiative promotes fishing as a family-friendly, fun activity that thousands of people across the state already enjoy and encourages others to get outside with their children and give fishing a try.

Furthermore, it stands to attract major fishing tournaments currently held in other states with the promise of catching another world-record bass in our state. The Go Fish Education Center takes visitors on an educational journey through Georgia's watersheds to learn about our diverse aquatic wildlife, their natural habitats and the impacts of water pollution. Beyond that, the **Center** serves as a great resource of fishing information for any level of angler – where to go, what to use and when." Voter ID Rules | To vote in the November 6th general election you will need to show photo identification. The accepted documents include a valid state or federal government-issued photo ID, which can be a voter ID card, issued free of charge by your county, or one of the following documents: Georgia driver's license (even if expired), a valid passport, a valid U.S. military ID card or a valid tribal identification card.
